Tutoring at the OAE is available in four formats:

- **individual tutoring** (by appointment; from \$12 to \$15/hr and free to members of some programs): you may locate a qualified tutor online through our TutorFind Directory, online and in our office. If you are a member of an on-campus support services program, ask your program coordinator about the tutor directory.
- Free **group tutoring**, available in over 30 courses each semester (mostly in the areas of math, science and business), based on student demand.
- free **drop-in tutoring** in math and science.
- Free **Supplemental Instruction (SI)** in select courses.



Tutoring is part of an integrated system of advising, mentoring, and workshops designed to help you succeed in achieving your overall goals at UD. Rather than just solving a few problems or giving you quick answers to specific questions, we emphasize improving the understanding of fundamental concepts and developing independence and confidence in tackling difficult problems/questions. We believe that you should never feel hesitant or embarrassed about asking for tutoring or seeking academic assistance. All we ask in return is your willingness to sit down, concentrate and put in the effort necessary to learn.
